

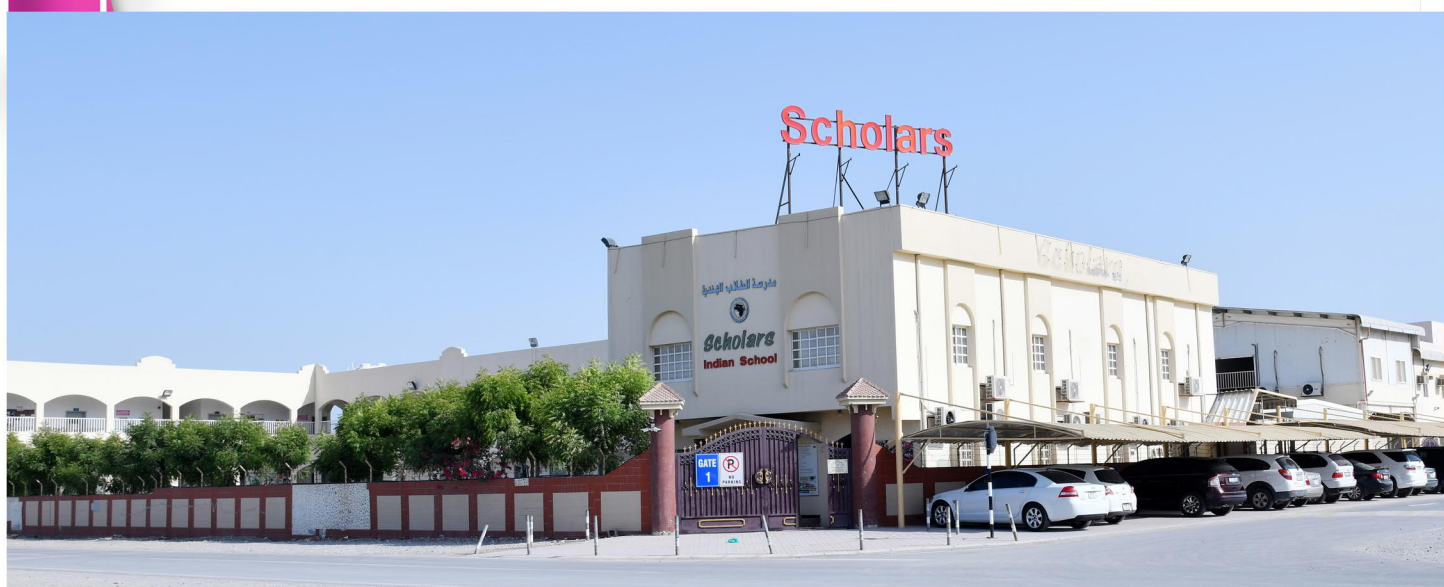

## **‘Your positive action combined with positive thinking results in success’**

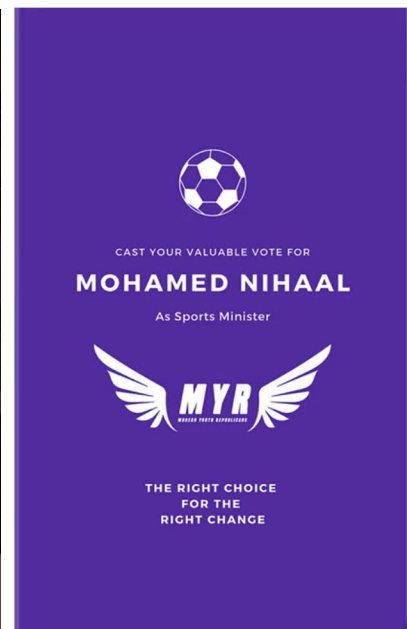
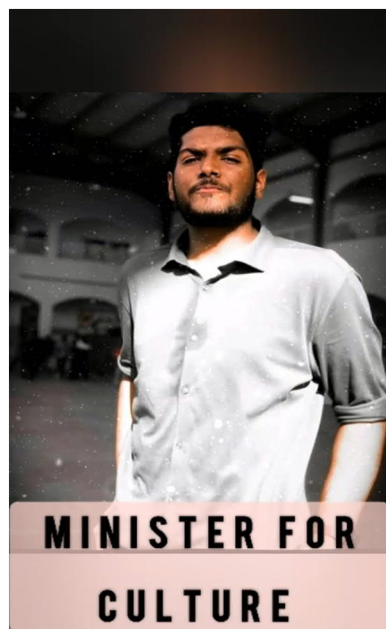

His tact in reciting the English version of 46 shlokas in 9 minutes and 17 seconds, at such a tender age was the talk of the town, and so much so that the record would be featured in India Book of Records 2022.
