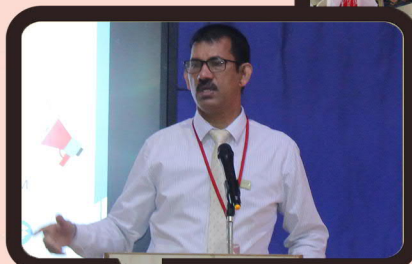
Online Safety: “e-Safety at School & IT Infrastructure Management”

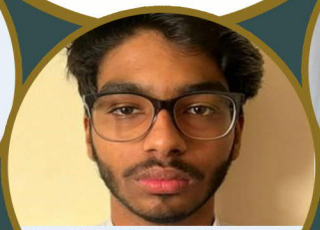

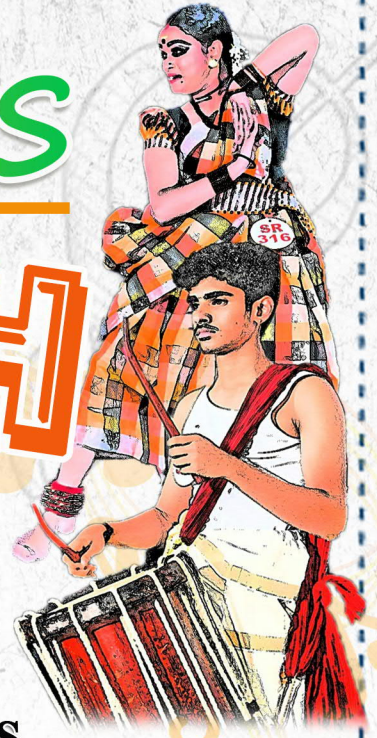

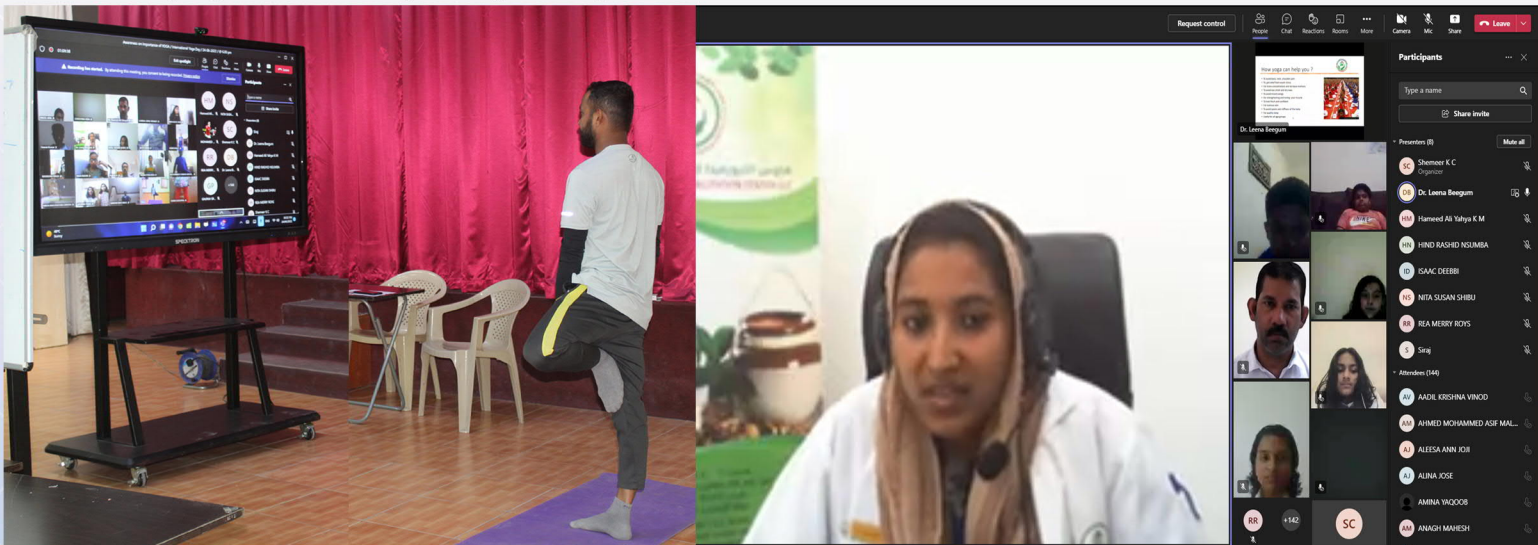
