


RESULTS OF GRADE X & XII CBSE BOARD EXAMINATION 2020-2021



RESULTS OF GRADE X CBSE BOARD EXAMINATION 2020-2021












RESULTS OF GRADE XII (SCIENCE) CBSE BOARD EXAMINATION 2020-2021



A special Video Show was also organized on 2nd and 3rd June, 2021 respectively, by the




'The greatest threat to our planet is the belief that someone else will save it'

SCHOLARS CODING CLUB


'Technology like art is a soaring exercise of the human imagination'
