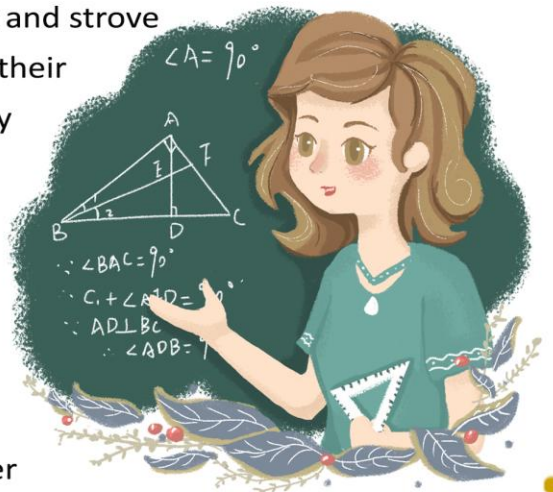
# CHAIRMAN'S AWARD 2018-2019

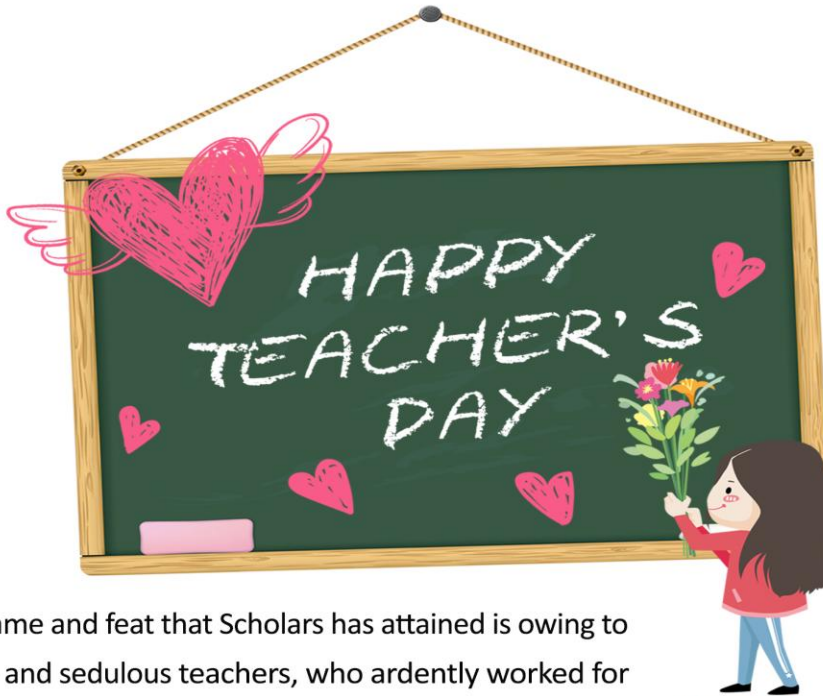


## MATHS QUIZ GRAND FINALE 2019-20
