

CBSE BOARD EXAMINATION RESULTS 2024-2025





MARKING MATTERS!

On April 29, a valuable professional development session was conducted by Ms. Dimpy Choudhary from the RAK Department of Knowledge (RAK DOK), aimed at equipping teachers with effective strategies for marking and feedback. The focus of the session was on making "marking matter" by encouraging purposeful and meaningful interactions with students' notebooks.

Teachers were guided to help students build a genuine relationship with their notebooks, transforming them into tools for reflection and critical thinking rather than mere repositories of information. Emphasis was placed on developing consistent notebook routines, establishing a clear sense of audience, and celebrating mistakes as learning opportunities. Mrs. Dimpy also encouraged teachers to motivate students to personalize and decorate their notebooks, fostering a sense of ownership and pride. Practical strategies such as using correction codes, colour pens for feedback, and promoting student-led review were introduced to make notebooks more dynamic and student-centered.

The session served as a refreshing reminder that effective marking goes beyond correctionsit helps nurture independent thinking, creativity, and a deeper engagement with learning.







The CAT4 Examination was conducted from September 10 to 12, 2025, at Scholars Indian Private School for students of Grades 3, 5, 7, and 9. Designed to assess cognitive potential beyond academic attainment, the Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4) serves as a comprehensive diagnostic tool that evaluates learners across four core reasoning domains—verbal, non-verbal, quantitative, and spatial.

The administration of this examination aimed to provide a deeper understanding of students' cognitive profiles, enabling educators to adopt data-informed strategies that nurture individual learning styles and intellectual growth. Armed with this information, teachers can tailor future lesson plans to effectively address any learning gaps or deficits identified among their students, thereby ensuring a more focused and inclusive approach to learning. The sessions were conducted with precision and academic integrity, ensuring a seamless and conducive testing environment for all participants.

As Benjamin Bloom profoundly remarked, "All children can learn; some just need more time and different approaches." The CAT4 assessment resonates with this philosophy, empowering educators to unlock each learner's potential and cultivate a culture of personalized, evidence-based education.
