The IT department participated in a series of workshops focused on robotic projects incorporating AI technology. These workshops for teachers were held on May 11, June 6, and June 28, 2024, and were conducted by Mr. Harish from Tachyon IT Consultancy, Dubai.

The workshops provided an in-depth exploration of various aspects of robotics and AI integration. Key components of the sessions included Robotic kit components, assembling of the components, programming the device and to explore the different projects that could be designed using the Robotic kit components. The main focus is on projects related to sustainable environment, Iot devices, AI image Classification System, Fraud Detection System, Voice Assistant etc.

The workshops were instrumental in enhancing the IT department's capabilities in robotics and AI, equipping participants with the skills to develop innovative projects that address contemporary technological and environmental challenges.

A Robotic lab training session was given to students of Grade 1 to Grade 9. The session started with introduction to basic concept of Robotics. A detailed explanation of components of Robotic Kit was given to students. It was followed by basic construction techniques and the tools available for the purpose were explained and demonstrated to students. Functions of the basic robotic parts were explained, especially the brain and the different types of sensors. Students were asked to plan a project and they constructed a model based on their project. The session was then followed by introduction to Avishkaar app especially Avishkaar maker studio-AI Mode to program the brain. The main content of the app are Hardware, AI and machine Learning, Python, Simulators and Game Builder. Students were interested and they were fully engaged in the workshop.



On account of the Silver Jubilee, the Malayalam Souhardhya Koottayma conducted a Souhardhya Sandhya by the Malayalam Department of Scholars Indian Private School, Ras Al Khaimah, for the academic year 2024-25 on May 23rd at the school premises.






